

- 1. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Either physical exam within 24 hours of admission OR proof of exam within 90 days of admission (by R.N., P.A., ARNP, or MD).
- 2. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Clothing and Allowances Arrangements.
- 3. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Child's parent or guardian has given expressed and informed consent to treatment.
- 4. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Written consent from parent/guardian authorizing medical, dental and emergency procedures.
- 5. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Arrangements regarding the child leaving the facility.
- 6. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Order of court commitment or a voluntary placement agreement with parents, quardian, or legal custodian;
- 7. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Documentation that parent/guardian and guardian ad litem understand policy regarding the use of restraint or seclusion.
- 8. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Arrangements for family phone calls and visits.
- 9. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Request for the child's discharge placement and contact person who will participate in treatment and discharge planning upon completion of treatment.
- 10. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Legal Guardian Contact or court ordered custodian information.
- 11. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Medical Information and history with list of current medications.
- 12. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Funding source has been secured for the expected treatment time. If the department is the funding source, need written approval from the department's mental health program office.
- 13. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Packet Completion of Immunization status.
- 14. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Req The child has an emotional disturbance as defined under 394.492(5)(6), which states child under 18 with DSM dx of mental, emotional, behavioral disorder.
- 15. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Req Provider is qualified by staff, program and equipment to give the treatment required by the child's condition, age and cognitive ability;
- 16. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Req The nature, purpose and expected length of the treatment have been explained to the child and the child's parent or guardian and guardian ad litem.

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- 17. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Admission Req Less restrictive treatment was considered or was unavailable AND this treatment is likely to resolve child's presenting problems.
- 18. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes assessments including diagnosis
- 19. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes school and grade,
- 20. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes birthdate and social security number,
- 21. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes final diagnosis, both psychiatric and physical, shall be recorded in full without the use of symbols or abbreviations.
- 22. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes previous placements with admission and discharge dates, dependency and delinquency actions affecting the minor's legal status
- 23. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes referral source and reason for residential treatment
- 24. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes individual progress notes
- 25. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes gender and race
- 26. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes admission date
- 27. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes medication record including dosage frequency, amount, who administered, and method of administration.
- 28. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Child Record Child's record includes child and parent/guardian's name, address, Phone
- 29. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Discharge plan includes aftercare plans developed by staff under clinical director guidance, encouraging participation of child, parent/guardian and guardian ad litem.
- 30. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Evidence of at least one contact with the discharged child and his parent or guardian and guardian ad litem within the first 30 days following discharge.
- 31. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Discharge plan includes projected discharge date, name, address, phone and relationship of person or organization to whom the child will be discharged
- 32. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Discharge plan, signed by treatment team, and provided to parent/guardian, guardian ad litem and department 30 days before discharge date

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- 33. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Discharge plan includes treatment summary and services provided in relation to problems on admission and identification of needs for continuing treatment
- 34. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Records of discharged children shall be completed within 15 business days following discharge.
- 35. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Records of discharged children shall be completed within 15 business days following discharge.
- 36. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Discharge plan includes recommendations for child and parent/guardian following release, including mental health service referrals
- 37. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Discharge plan is signed by treating psychiatrist.
- 38. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Discharge plan includes the initial diagnosis
- 39. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Discharge Child discharged only to parent/guardian or placing organization, unless Court ordered.
- 40. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Out-of-State In addition to above Discharge criteria, Within 10 business days of child's departure, provider shall complete, date, and sign an Interstate Compact Report on Child's Placement Status, (ICPC-100B) Form.
- 41. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Out-of-State At least 30 days before the proposed discharge, a copy of the discharge summary shall be sent to the child's home district, legal guardian, guardian ad litem and DCF.
- 42. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Placement Agreem Placement agreement includes the conditions for the child's release from the program;
- 43. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Placement Agreem Placement agreement includes provisions for treatment plan reviews;
- 44. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Placement Agreem Placement agreement includes designation of aftercare services or Adult Mental Health services, if applicable.
- 45. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Placement Agreem Placement agreement includes the frequency and types of regular contact and visitation for child's family, which is flexible for family's work schedule.
- 46. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Placement Agreem Placement agreement includes payment of care and any fees to be covered;
- 47. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Placement Agreem Placement agreement includes complaint procedures that include a method of appeal to provider management if not resolved to the satisfaction of the child, parent or guardian.

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- 48. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Placement Agreem Placement agreement includes a statement signed by the parent or guardian acknowledging they are aware of their responsibility to keep the provider aware of any changes in their address or telephone number
- 49. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Placement Agreem Placement agreement includes a plan for sharing information about the child's care and development with the parent, guardian, the guardian ad litem, and the department;
- 50. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Includes service agencies and other support systems
- 51. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Includes treatment provided is in response to presenting problem
- 52. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Developed within 14 days, signed and dated by child, parent(s) or guardian, child welfare or case manager, and guardian ad litem. Document if a child is incapable of signing.
- 53. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Provider shall submit a written report of findings with discharge plans to the department and Parents/guardian every 30 days.
- 54. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Includes observable/measurable goals and objectives, including staff interventions
- 55. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Treatment goal of discharging to the community or a step-down program within 120 days of admission for residential treatment centers and 365 days for therapeutic group homes.
- 56. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Includes family and social strengths and needs
- 57. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Includes physical, behavior, psychological, developmental, dx, family, education, discharge placement.
- 58. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Treatment Plan Review within 30 days of admission and monthly thereafter with input from child, parent/guardian, & stakeholders to determine readiness to move to a less restrictive placement, discharge plans, etc.
- 59. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Includes frequency, completion date, staff responsible,
- 60. Children's Residential 65E-9 Cx Trx Plan Includes expected degree of parent/guardian involvement and contact

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
