



What is aquaponics?

 Closed-loop system that combines <u>aquaculture</u> (raising of fish, shrimp, snails, etc.) and <u>hydroponics</u> (growing produce in water)

<u>Aqua</u>culture + Hydroponics = <u>Aquaponics</u>

Aquaponics is a farming system in which the waste produced by farmed fish or other aquatic animals supplies nutrients for plants grown hydroponically, which in turn purify the water.
