## Judges Award – Scoring Criteria

Criteria	Score
<p><b>The video clearly identifies a problem or unmet need, a proposed solution and who will benefit from the solution:</b></p> <p>1 = there is no clearly defined unmet need, solution or defined population 2 = one of the elements, (problem, solution or population) is defined but not clearly articulated 3 = two of the elements (problem, solution or population) are defined but not clearly articulated 4 = all of the elements (problem, solution and population) are defined but not clearly articulated 5 = all three elements (problem, solution and population) are clearly defined and clearly articulated</p>	
<p><b>The proposed solution is unique and innovative:</b></p> <p>1 = the proposed solution is similar or the same as other existing solutions or models 2 = the proposed solution builds on an existing solution, applies to a new population or setting 3 = the proposed solution improves an existing process or model 4 = the proposed solution demonstrates a new or more efficient use of resources 5 = the proposed solution is a unique or “breakthrough” approach</p>	

Criteria	Score
<p><b>The video describes the potential impact of the proposed solution:</b></p> <p>1 = the impact of the solution is not clearly stated or demonstrated            2 = the impact of the solution is clearly described but impact is minimal and limited in scope or affects a small population            3 = the impact of the solution is clearly described and impact is moderate in scope and affects a broad population of moderate need            4 = the impact of the solution is clearly described and impacts a small but high need population            5 = the impact of the solution is clearly described and impacts a large population of high need</p>	
<p><b>The proposed solution can be scaled or replicated:</b></p> <p>1 = the proposed solution is a “one off” that requires very specific conditions or resources that are difficult or impossible to replicate or expand            3 = the proposed solution can be replicated or scaled with specific specialized resources or in specific settings            5 = the proposed solution can be readily replicated or scaled in a variety of settings</p>	
<p><b>The video presents preliminary data on effectiveness or outcomes for the proposed solution:</b></p> <p>1 = No data or information on outcomes is provided            2 = proposed outcomes are outlined but no data is provided            3 = anecdotal data on outcomes or effectiveness are discussed            4 = a limited amount of data (6 months or less) is presented demonstrating outcomes or effectiveness            5 = 6 or more months of data demonstrating outcomes or effectiveness is presented</p>	
<p><b>Wow Factor:</b></p> <p>A score from 1 to 5 reflecting the judge’s overall impression of the presenter’s/solution’s creativity, originality, passion and potential to create positive change</p>
