## **Indigent Psychiatric Medication Program (IDP)**

- 1. Indigent Psychiatric Medication Program (IDP) 01 (Incorporated Document 25, Ch. 394, F.S.) Is the client a member of at least one of the Department's priority populations and documentation is in client's chart?
- 2. Indigent Psychiatric Medication Program (IDP) 02 (Incorporated Document 25, Ch. 394, F.S.) Has the NSP documented in client's chart that he/she does not reside in a state mental health treatment facility or an inpatient community unit?
- 3. Indigent Psychiatric Medication Program (IDP) 03 (Incorporated Document 25, Ch. 394, F.S.) Is there documentation in the client's chart verifying client's net family income is at or below 150 percent of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines?
- 4. Indigent Psychiatric Medication Program (IDP) 04 (Incorporated Document 25, Ch. 394, F.S.) Has the NSP documented in client's chart that he/she lacks third-party insurance or other psychotropic medications funding sources?
- 5. Indigent Psychiatric Medication Program (IDP) 05 (Incorporated Document 25, Ch. 394, F.S.) Is there documentation in the client's chart verifying the client does not participate in a program where other funding sources pay for psychotropic medications?
- 6. Indigent Psychiatric Medication Program (IDP) 06 (Incorporated Document 25, Ch. 394, F.S.) If client has a third-party insurance for psychotropic medications but was temporarily denied benefits for these medications and receiving IDP medications, has the NSP documented such in client's chart?
- 7. Indigent Psychiatric Medication Program (IDP) 07 (Incorporated Document 25, Chapter 394, F.S.) Has the NSP documented in the client's chart that they have given information to IDP individuals regarding adverse effects, side effects, possible allergic reactions, and instructions on what to do in case of an emergency? (This can be verified by a disclaimer or form in the client chart.)

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
