


Mental Well-being: A funding priority

 - Support in addressing stress, anxiety, loneliness, addiction, etc.



WHY YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID?

Youth Mental Health First Aid teaches you how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illness and substance use disorders in youth. This **FREE** 6-hour training (provided by grants from the **Florida Blue Foundation and SAMHSA**) gives adults who work with youth the skills they need to reach out and provide initial support to children and adolescents (ages 6-18) who may be developing a mental health or substance use problem and help connect them to the appropriate care. The Florida Blue Foundation - NSU MD Opioid Initiative has impacted over 6,000 youth and 300 youth serving professionals across Florida.


